Flow Chart

Use a Flow Chart to sequence or order information. A Flow Chart can be used to show sequence of events, to summarize events, or to predict and track events. For instance, ballads tell a story, so a Flow Chart can help students follow and understand the story line of a song by organizing the events in the order in which they happen. Similarly, a Flow Chart can be used to show the sequence of events in a composition—form.

Information or events being sequenced can be numbered, or simply ordered. One of the following Flow Charts in this PDF may suit you and your students' organizational needs. However, it may be advantageous for students to draw their own Flow Charts, adding information and arrows as appropriate or needed.
